What items do I need upon admission to a AMFM center?

Upon admission, please bring the following items with you:

- *Social Security Card*
- *Insurance Card(s)*
- *Medicaid Card*
- *Driver's License/Identification*
- *Medical Power of Attorney (MPOA)*
- *Living Will*



Residents are encouraged to complete a West Virginia Advanced Directive (WVAD) prior to admission. A copy of the WVAD documents is available in our Social Services office.

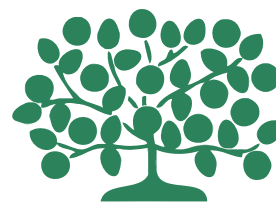
What items from home should I bring with me during my visit?

You are more than welcome to bring items such as pictures, flowers, blankets, and other items to make your visit as home-like and comfortable as possible. We ask that jewelry, valuable items and money not be kept in the patient's room.

However, if needed the facility can provide a small lock box for storage of some personal items of value. Our facility team members will assist you or your loved ones in labeling clothing. Other ideal items to bring may include:

- *Bring at least 5-7 outfits appropriate for the current season.*
- *Comfortable pants/slacks, shorts or sweatpants.*
- *Comfortable shirts or blouses.*
- *Sweaters or sweatshirts.*
- *Comfortable slippers, and non-skid shoes such as tennis shoes.*
- *Pajamas and undergarments, socks.*
- *Glasses, dentures and hearing aids used at home.*
- *Personal items and toiletries.*
